Mowing Along

There has been some ongoing mowing within our CCSD Properties to maintain weed control. The focus is on the East and West Ranches, which need some touching up to be completed. The crew has a deadline of September 1st due to nesting season commencing. This will also include the Santa Rosa Trail, which will need extensive vegetation and tree breach removal. Closure of this area may be implemented during that time.

Homeless Encampments Removal

There has been very little activity within the district recently. Last week, we removed 9 cubic yards of debris, approximately 3,200 lbs., from the Santa Rosa Creek embankment next to HWY 1 and Steelhead Park. This was one person with several locations within the area of question. The cost of labor/materials and fees was approximately \$700

Our department has a better presence patrolling the areas known for activity. We are training the crew on what to look for and the proper guidelines the state and county implement, especially the easements we currently have for our open spaces.

















On Going Graffiti

There has been some graffiti activity within the CCSD. We have been on the lookout in several areas, and we have been removing or covering it up to prevent it from becoming an eyesore to the public.

The ongoing cleanup for this department has been over \$1,200 dollars so far with materials and labor.
